Meet Pixit - Available for Adoption

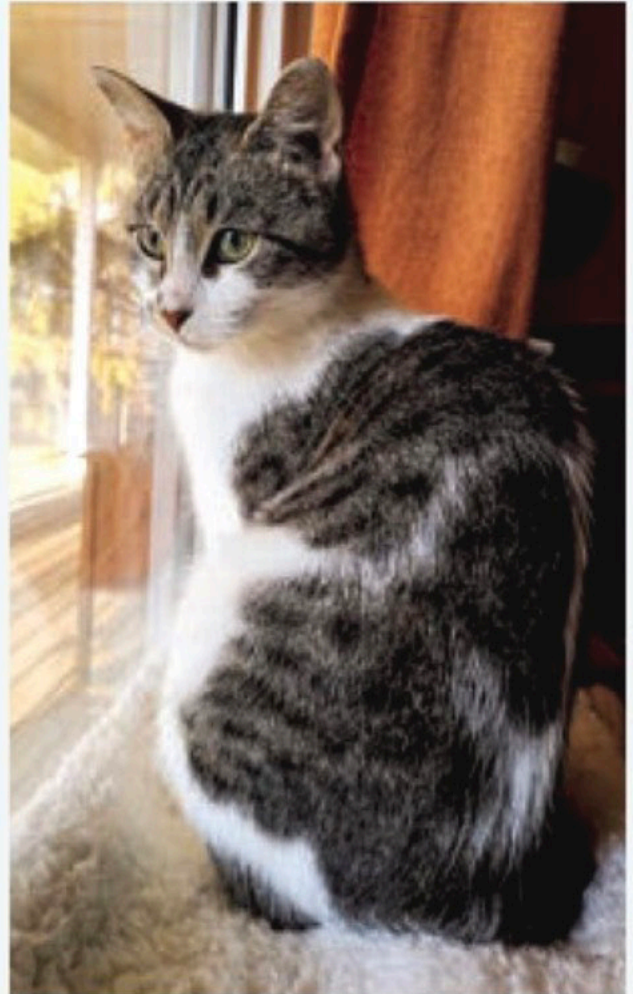
Hello, my name is Pixit!
